



This geographic diversity offers a multitude of travel experiences, the dense jungle picturesque mountain villages and tropical beaches. The Galápagos, an isolated archipelago, add a special dimension to this diversity by hosting unique world-endemic animal and plant species. Travelers have the rare opportunity to get up close with the incredibly adapted wildlife.



Useful Tips for Traveling in Ecuador

Language: The official language is Spanish, in addition to 14 indigenous languages, but English is relatively well-spoken in tourist areas.

Health and Safety: Adhere to health precautions in the Amazon, at high altitudes, and in coastal regions.

Climate: Ecuador experiences climatic diversity based on altitude and region. Pack appropriate clothing.

Currency and Payments: The local currency is the United States Dollar (USD). \$50 and \$100 bills are often not accepted. Prefer bills of \$20 or less. Credit cards are accepted in all cities.

Respect for the Environment and Culture: Show respect for nature and local customs. The local population is friendly; feel free to ask them questions.

Transport: Buses and taxis are widely used for city transportation. Domestic flights and guided excursions are also popular.

Food: Try local dishes like ceviche on the coast and Andean cuisine. Sanitary standards are good, but avoid tap water and opt for bottled water.

Restaurants, cafés, bars: In restaurants, it's common to leave a tip of 10% to 15% of the total bill if service is not included. In cafes and bars, a small tip of a few dollars or leaving some change is sufficient.

Taxi Cabs: Tips are generally not expected for taxi rides, but rounding up the amount is a nice gesture.

Hotels: In hotels, a tip to the housekeeping staff of 1 to 2 dollars per day is usually appreciated.

Guides and Excursions: During guided tours, a tip can be given to the guide based on the quality of service. On average, consider tipping around 5 to 10 dollars per day.

Porters and Baggage Handlers: If you use the services of porters or baggage handlers at the airport or hotel, a tip of 1 to 2 dollars per bag is appreciated.

Public Restrooms: In some public restrooms, an attendant may ask for a small tip. A symbolic amount is usually sufficient.

Altitude: The Ecuadorian Andes are a spectacular mountainous region with peaks reaching high altitudes. We advise all travelers with respiratory or cardiovascular issues to consult a doctor before their trip and plan for a gradual acclimatization period.

Sea Sickness: Sea sickness can be a concern for some people when traveling by boat in the Galápagos, as the waters can be choppy. Consult your doctor before your departure.

Ecuador, located between land and sea, provides an exceptional travel experience where the majesty of the Amazon rainforest, the peaks of the Andean volcanoes, the wild beaches of the Pacific coast, and the unique flora and fauna of the Galápagos Islands come together to create a captivating cultural, geographic, and historical diversity. 
The Galápagos Islands are also classified as a UNESCO World Heritage site, a true natural laboratory where you can observe species of animals that are unique in the world.































Before leaving, make sure to **check the validity of your passport**. It should be valid for at least **six months beyond your return date to your home country**. This check is essential to ensure a smooth entry into the country and a **worry-free journey**.

On your to-do list, this is the first and most important thing to do!



Vaccines and Vaccinations

Should I get vaccinated against yellow fever, COVID-19, Chikungunya, Dengue, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Rabies, Tuberculosis, Typhoid, Zika, and take malaria prophylaxis? It's advisable; they are **all recommended** (but not mandatory). Regarding malaria, the Amazon and the Pacific coast are classified as zone 3 by global health authorities. Some travelers take malaria prophylaxis, while others prefer appropriate repellent.



Vaccinations are recommended based on **your health condition**, **age**, and **specific destination**, as these recommendations often pertain to very localized areas. If you are planning an extended, adventurous, or **remote trip**, especially with **young children**, it is indeed preferable to get vaccinated. However, in the majority of cases, these vaccines will not be necessary. If in doubt, **consult your doctor**.

Visas

Europeans and **US citizens** do not usually need a visa to visit Ecuador, but the rules may change. **Before you depart, inquire with the Ecuadorian consulate in your country.**

Visa is not required for a tourist stay of 90 days or less.


Insurance

When paying for your trip with a credit card, you generally receive coverage. However, it is advisable to confirm this information with your bank and, if necessary, consult an insurer or a specialist like <u>chapkadirect.com</u>.

High-Risk Areas

The border areas with Colombia and the province of Esmeraldas pose a high risk due to drug trafficking, in particular. Fortunately, these areas are relatively limited, but it's advisable to be aware of them.

Travelers who book their trips through an agency generally won't have to worry about these issues, as their itineraries are designed with safety considerations in mind, whether related to natural or non-natural risks.
